We're happy to announce this year's "Young Lynxes Open Call for Visual Artists". We're looking for international, professional artists who want a chance to have their work printed in our magazine. From the submitted applications we will select:

- 6 artists whose portfolios will be published in Contemporary Lynx's Weekly Online Magazine,
 - In the monthly newsletter,
 - Via social media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Pinterest);
 - The winners will also receive a one year subscription to our paper magazine delivered straight to their door.

- 2 artists will receive the Carte Blanche Prize:
 - 3000 PLN each
 - Exhibition in Willa Biała, Warsaw (dates: 11 July 2019 or 17 November 2019)
 - Promotion
 - Professional support during setup

- All participants who submit their works will receive an archival issue of Contemporary Lynx Magazine sent directly to their door.

Contemporary Lynx Magazine is an international and independent publication for art, design, collecting and photography in visual culture. With specially commissioned artworks, bespoke covers and specific themes, it features interviews with key figures in the art world and a range of insightful essays that debate current trends in the arts. The magazine is focused on looking out for new and emerging artists, hunting for news on the art scene and sharing information.

Carte Blanche – 26 April 2018 marked the premiere of a new experimental art programme in Warsaw, 'Carte Blanche', launched by LETO, Contemporary Lynx Magazine and Biała. Young promising artists are given the opportunity to exhibit their works during special art events taking place at the former avant-garde modernist villa, 'The White Villa', located in the Saska Kępa district in Warsaw.

Young Lynxes Open Call Regulations:

1. Aim of the Open Call

The aim of the Young Lynxes Open Call is to promote visual artists and give them space to present their works to a wider international audience. The jury will choose 6 artists, whose portfolios will be published in Contemporary Lynx Weekly Online Magazine, and 2 winners who will receive an exhibition at Willa Biała in Warsaw.

2. Age and Education Requirement

The competition is devoted to international artists, who want to present their works. Young Lynxes is open to all visual artists who have graduated art academies or are in the last year of study. There is no age limit.

3. Application Files

4. Portfolio

Artists should submit their original portfolio, containing reproductions of works (all techniques and media from the realm of visual arts are welcome), a short biography, details of their educational background, lists of major exhibitions, scholarships, artistic residences, and descriptions of works, techniques and comments on projects, if needed. The portfolio can also contain external links to websites or films. NOTE: your portfolio cannot be on a website or in an external link!

IMPORTANT: You need to include and specially mark at least 6 works that are available to show in case of winning the Carte Blanche Prize and preparing the exhibition.

5. File Sizes and Formats

Your portfolio must be sent in PDF format, not bigger than 10 MB.

Portfolios must be submitted up until midday Central European Time on the 12 June 2019. No portfolios will be accepted after the deadline.

16. Jurors

- First selection: The jurors will be the chief editors of Contemporary Lynx Magazine: Dobromiła Błaszczyk and Sylwia Krasoń, and the content manager Anna Dziuba. The jury will have 7 days to consider the applications. The decision of the jury is final and indisputable. The jury will choose 6 artists.
- Second selection: Carte Blanche Prize. The jurors will be the chief editors of Contemporary Lynx Magazine, Zuzanna Zakaryan from PURO Hotels, Marta Kołakowska from LETO Gallery, Hubert Karsz from Grupa Warszawa, Newsweek journalist Alek Hudzik, and Małgorzata Szczepańska from ELLE Decoration.

17. List of Winners

The list of winners will be posted on our website until 22 June 2019.

18. Award

- First selection: The jury will choose 6 winning artists. Each winning artist will receive:
 - Publication of their portfolio in the "Portfolio" section on our website contemporarylynx.co.uk (each month we will publish one portfolio);

- A one year subscription to Contemporary Lynx Magazine on paper delivered straight to the winner's door;
- Promotion of their portfolio on social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Pinterest) and Newsletter.



Second selection, the jury will choose 2 winners – 2 artists who will receive the Carte Blanche Prize:

- 3000 PLN each founded by PURO Hotels;
- Exhibition in Willa Biała, Warsaw (date: 11 July 2019 or 17 November 2019);
- Promotion;
- Professional support during setup.

Your art must be your own original concept and not a copy of anyone else's copyrighted material. (If your image infringes upon another's copyright it will be disqualified.) Upon submitting your work to this competition, you are solely responsible for any infringement on copyrighted materials.

20. Copyright

The artist retains all copyrights to their artwork without exception.

21. Non-exclusive Permissions

By entering this competition, you are granting us a non-exclusive perpetual licence to reproduce images of your artwork on our website contemporarylynx.co.uk and in our newsletters, and in the marketing of art competitions to the general public. Artworks will not be used for any other purpose than that which is stated here. All winning entries will be displayed on our website contemporarylynx.co.uk. Each entry becomes part of the public, historical/archival online contest catalogue. It can be removed at a later date upon request.
